Making comparisons -the pattern

Stó:lō Shxwelí Language Program

This story practises the comparative, the pattern which translates into English as big/bigger, fast/faster, good/better, etc. The Halq'emeylem pattern is formed with yeláwel.

yeláw can mean 'over', 'after', 'past', and sometimes also 'next'.

yeláwel is translated as 'more' here, and is used to form the comparative (e.g. tall, taller (=more tall) and tallest (=most tall). Yeláwel is used to both say 'more' and most' and context will determine whether the 'more' or 'most' meaning is appropriate.



To create the **-er** form (e.g. bigg-**er**), you use yeláwel before the adjective.

yeláwel	híkw	bigger
	xwem/stím	faster
	éy	better
	tl'eqtameth'	taller
	schewót	smarter

If you want to compare to something else, and say something is ______-er than something else, you use telí.

For example: yeláwel éy telí tl'á'altha (he/she/it is better than me)

Yeláwel	híkw	telí	tl'á'altha
	xwem		te letám
	éy		te sqwemáy
