

- <=**elh**>, da //=**əʔ**//, WV /'weaving, mat'/ as in <**wól=á:lh**> *bulrush/tule mat*, and <**swôqw'elh**>, df //s=wóq'w=**əʔ**//, WV /'woven goat-wool blanket, (twilled weave (JL))/' possibly lit. /'downriver weaving'.
- <**elhápt**>, df //ʔə(=)ʔéɸ=T or ʔəʔ(=)éɸ=T//, pcs, ABFC ['slip it out'], semantic environment ['of penis from vagina (in the only example I have)'], Elder's comment: "what a woman will tell a man if she doesn't want to get pregnant", possibly <=**e**> unknown meaning (not likely *continuative*), <=**t**> *purposeful control transitivizer*, syntactic analysis: transitive verb, attested by JL (7/20/79) (compare <**xwlhép**> *slip off* and <**xwelhxwélhepxel**> *slip with both feet* and <**xwlhépelets**> *sat down (with plop), (slip of on rump)*, if these are related they would have to have been reanalyzed and <**xw**> would have to be an error for <**xw=>** *become, get*), Salish cognate: perhaps Squamish /ʔup/ *be out of reach, be away from the edge, be way off* (corresponding with Halkomelem /ʔap/ with =AÉ= needed to explain) and Squamish /ʔúp-n/ *put away (tr.)* and /ʔúp-cut/ *move away* K67:329-330.
- <=**elhcha**>, da //=**əʔcɛ**//, WATR /'unclear liquid, water, juice', syntactic analysis: lexical suffix, derivational suffix; found in <**lhéxwélhcha**>, //ʔəx'w=**əʔcɛ**//, /'(to) spit', <**lhéxwelhcha**>, //ʔəx'w=**əʔcɛ**//, /'spitting', <**slhéxwelhcha**>, //s=ʔəx'w=**əʔcɛ**//, /'spit, saliva' (compare <**lh(e)xw=ó:t**> (to) spit), <**th'eqwélhcha**>, //è'əq'w=**əʔcɛ**//, /'mudpuddle, dirty pond' (root meaning unclear), <**qó:lhcha**>, //qá'=**əʔcɛ**//, /'juicy' (root <**qó:**> water), <**Swí:lhcha**>, //s=wí'ʔcɛ//, /'Cultus Lake'.
- <=**elhlát ~ =lhát**>, da //=**əʔ=léɸ ~ =ʔéɸ**//, TIME ['day of the week'], possibly <=**elh**> *times* or *past*, possibly <=**lát**> *night*, literally /'past night', syntactic analysis: lexical suffix, derivational suffix, also <=**lhát**>, //=**ʔéɸ**//; found in <**Sxexelhlát ~ Sxexelhát**>, //sxəx=**əʔ=léɸ**//, /'Sunday', literally /'sacred + day of the week', <**Yilá:welhlát ~ Yelá:welhát**>, //yilé'w=**əʔ=léɸ**//, /'Monday', literally /'passed or after + day of the week', Salish cognate: Musqueam /=**əʔnéɸ**/ *day*.
- <=**élhelh ~ =lhelh ~ poss. =elhleh**>, da //=**əʔəʔ ~ =ʔəʔ ~ =əʔləɸ**//, ANA /in the windpipe, throat/, found in <**t'eqw'élhelh**>, ds //t'əq'w=**əʔəʔ**//, ABDF /'pass out, faint', literally /'break (flexible obj.)/run out of breath/cut off in the windpipe', (compare cognate Nooksack //t'k'w=**əʔni**// *faint* (PA: SJ), and <**shxwehóméllhelh**>, df //sx'w=q'əh'é=ámól=**ʔəʔ** or s=x'wəh=ámól=**ʔəʔ**//, ANA ['adam's apple'], literally perhaps /'something that goes through a tunnel/hole part of in the windpipe/throat' (root *xwehó*).
- <=**elhót**>, da //=**əʔ=át**//, N ['female name'], syntactic analysis: lexical suffix, derivational suffix; found in <**Xwóylhot**>, //x'wáy'ʔat//, /'Indian name of Amy Cooper's mother's mother', <**Ólmelhót ~ Élmelhó:t**>, //ʔálm=**əʔ=át** ~ ʔól'mə=**ʔà·t**//, /'Indian name of Amy Cooper's father's mother and of Amy's granny Lorenzetto's oldest twin', <**Kwoxwilhót**>, //k'wax'w=**iʔ=át**//, /'Indian name of Miss Susanna Jim from Katz, grandmother of Mrs. Duncan (Dorothy) Wealick' (perhaps from root <**kwoxw**> *knock, rap* + <=**iyh**> *child, offspring* + =ot *female name*)—this raises the possibility that the <elh ~ ilh> part of the affix is the morpheme {=**iyh** ~ =elh} *child, offspring*.
- <=**elhp**>, da //=**əʔp**//, EB /'tree, plant', semantic environment ['with numerals 1-5, kw'í:l, non-numerals'], phonology: e + e rule predicts =á:lhɸ allomorph, comment: very productive, over 50 examples found so far, syntactic comment: obligatory with numerals for single owner, syntactic analysis: lexical suffix, derivational suffix, also <=**á:lhɸ**>, //=**é·ʔp**//, phonology: this form is not an allomorph but just the result of a final root vowel combining with =elhp by regular phonological rules; found in <**lhq'atsesálhɸ**>, //ʔq'əcəs=**éʔp**//, /'five trees (belonging to one person)', <**xé:yth'elhp ~ xéyth'elhp**>, //x'é(·)yè'=**əʔp**//, /'alder tree' (root <**xé(:)yth'**> *unripe*), <**qwe'ó:pelhp**>, //q'wə'á:p=**əʔp**//, /'(crab)apple tree' (root <**qwe'óp**> (crab)apple),
